


From the winding road D1075 from the Col de la Croix haute, the motorist is amazed by this limestone fortress erected above Grenoble. The Vercors, this mountain range of the Northern Alps between the Isère valley to the north and the Diois to the south, challenges with its wild beauty. The Vercors Regional Natural Park protects these spaces with a diversity of landscapes, exceptional flora and fauna. It is a little paradise for outdoor activities, away from the crowds, for both contemplatives and sportsmen. A territory accessible by deep gorges and dizzying roads.

The large natural areas of the Hautes Plateaux Reserve offer breathtaking breathtaking panoramas. It is entered after several hours of walking by "steps" difficult to cross. The arrival on these grassy and rocky expanses planted with hook pines gives a dizzying feeling of pleasure and freedom. The immense plateau is so vast that the hiker can walk for a long time without crossing a living soul, with the reward of observing the somewhat shy ibex, or of identifying the flight of griffon vultures, failing to see the elusive wolf!

In the southeast of the reserve, the landscape offers panoramas worthy of the great American spaces. One of the regional marvels attests to this, the atypical monolith of Mont Aiguille, which rises above the village of Chichilianne over 1,000 m, straight out of a film by John Ford, a "Mesa" from Colorado in French territory!

The hikes along the vertiginous high cliffs are striking and offer majestic panoramas on the distant mountain ranges of Dévoluy, Oisans or Ecrins. It is with astonished eyes and a pounding heart that we carefully approach the lip of the cliff.

Rich in natural and wild treasures, the emotions felt on the high plateaus of Vercors are the object of all superlatives.















